Safety matters

MCA Inspectors are now surveying fishing vessels. Make sure you are prepared. Not just for the vessel inspection but every day.

One hour per month is the minimum time to reflect. Prioritise wearing lifejackets, Personal Locator Beacons and doing your Emergency Drills. But use your inspection as the deadline for the improvements that your vessel or crew need. Take action.
