

## APPLICATION FOR FUNDED TRAINING INTRODUCTION TO COMMERCIAL FISHING COURSE

Complete this form if you are to applying for funding to undertake the 15-day Introduction to Commercial Fishing Course for new entrants.

To be eligible for funded training you **must**:

- be aged 15 (in the last year at school) or above
- attend an online selection interview
- commit to attend all 15 days of the course
- inform Seafish when you have successfully secured a position on a UK registered vessel

### How to Apply:

*Step 1 - before* applying, you must identify a training provider offering the course and establish the availability of a provisional place. Then complete this form and email it to [trainingadmin@seafish.co.uk](mailto:trainingadmin@seafish.co.uk) **We will not fund training retrospectively.**

*Step 2* - we will acknowledge receipt of your application and if your application is satisfactory you will be invited to an online interview to assess your suitability and commitment.

*Step 3* – we will email you to advise on the outcome of your interview within 14 days.

*Step 4* – if you have been successful at interview, you can proceed with confirming your place on the course with the training provider; your approval will be valid for three months. The training provider will be notified of your successful application and approved funding by Seafish.

### Data Protection:

Seafish and its Approved Training Providers have a legal obligation to keep a record of your personal details and any basic safety training that you have completed.
